Starters

Especially do so when you are using it for the first time!

This is the first frame belonging to the section 'Hello World'. Its source code looks like this:

```
\section{Hello World}
\subsection{}

\begin{frame}
  \frametitle{Hello Beamer}
  This is the first frame ...
\end{frame}
```

Another Example

This is another frame belonging to the section 'Hello World'.

```
\begin{frame}  
  \frametitle{Another Example}  
  This is another frame ...  
\end{frame}
```

The MPIFKF's colors are:

- `\MPIFKFdarkblue`
- `\MPIFKFbrightblue`
- `\MPIFKFgray`
- `\MPIFKFred`

Changing colors

Colors can be changed with

`\color{colorname}`

and

`\textcolor{colorname}{text}`

Block

This is a usual block.

```
\begin{block}{Block} ... \end{block}
```

Alerted block

This is an alerted block.

```
\begin{alertblock}{Alerted Block} ... \end{alertblock}
```

Example

This is an example block.

```
\begin{exampleblock}{Example} ... \end{exampleblock}
```

Itemize and Enumerate

Itemize:

- Level 1
 - Level 2
 - Level 3 (should not be used!)
- Level 1 again

Enumerate:

1. Level 1
 - 1.1 Level 2
 - 1.1.1 Level 3 (should not be used!)
 - 1.2 Another item
2. Still level 1

Mixed:

1. Level 1
 - Level 2
 - 1.1 Level 3 (should not be used!)



Can be compiled with

- `pdflatex`
- `latex + dvips`

Title(s) + author(s) + institute(s) in meta.tex

```

Set to true to show certain fields in “status bar”:

- `\showshortauthor`
- `\showdate`
- `\showshorttitle`
- `\showtotalnumberofframes`

Set to true to show mini frames aka section overview

- `\showminiframes`

Set to true to show slide with table of content slides

- `\includetoc`

Select of one the color schemes:

- `\MPIKFcolor{MPIKFdarkblue}`
- `\MPIKFcolor{MPIKFbrightblue}`
- `\MPIKFcolor{MPIKFgray}`

If you see gray text after a block, where you expect black text, your beamer version might be buggy. There is a simple fix: Check the file `beamerbaseboxes.sty` (located, e.g., under an MPI-linux in `/usr/share/texmf/tex/latex/beamer/base/`) and replace the line (#116)

```
\setbox\bmb@colorbox=\hbox\colorlower.bg
```

by

```
\setbox\bmb@colorbox=\hbox\pgfpicturetrue\pgfsetcolorlower.bg
```
