

Guidelines for posters:

- Please submit posters in portrait format, size A0 (ca. 84 cm*119 cm). The poster must be in JPG format with a maximum size of 25 MB. To obtain a JPG with good resolution from a ppt/pptx file, it is recommended to define the page size as A0 right from the beginning (better than starting with an A4 page). The link for poster upload will be sent close to the conference.
- A video chat room is available for each poster. Authors are asked to be present in the chat room during the assigned poster session. Specifically, authors for odd poster numbers should be present in the first hour of the session, and authors of even poster numbers in the second hour. Thus, poster authors have the chance to visit also other posters.
- During the poster session it may be helpful having the group video chat room for your poster open in one browser tab, and use a second tab if you want to view other posters, so you will not miss any chat requests for your poster.
- The chat rooms are available also outside the poster session, feel free to use them for individual discussions.
- To arouse interest for your poster, there is the possibility of a "video pitch" for your poster which can be accessed on-demand by the audience. The video must be in .mp4 format, and not exceed the maximum size of 150 MB. We recommend a maximum duration of 3 minutes.

To convert a video to .mp4 or reduce the file size, the conference platform recommends the "Handbrake" software: <https://handbrake.fr/>
